| House | HB 4094 | Medical amnesty for underage drinkers. Bill would allow an underage drinker or the companion of an underage drinker to seek medical help and not be at risk of arrest. | Relating to possession of alcohol by persons under 21 years of age | Judiciary | Enrolled Feb. 13: Passed in House 57-0 Feb. 20: Passed in Senate 30-0 |

| House | HB 4139 | Directs OSU and the Oregon Dept. of Agriculture to increase education for licensed pesticide applicators about pollinator protection. Creates a task force charged with bringing legislation to the 2015 session to address the threat that pesticides pose to pollinator health. 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| Senate | SB 1545 | Adds two legislators as nonvoting members of Oregon Ocean Science Trust | Relating to the Oregon Ocean Science Trust | Rural Communities & Economic Development | Enrolled Feb. 6: Passed in Senate 29-0 Feb. 19: Passed in House 55-0 |
| Senate | SB 1566 | Declares state public policy to promote coordinated provision of education, employment and job training. Declares an emergency, effective on passage. Introduced by Governor Kitzhaber. | Relating to the State Workforce Investment Board | Education & Workforce Development | Enrolled Feb. 18: Passed in Senate 30-0 Feb. 25: Passed in House 60-0 |
| Senate | SB 1574 | Clarifies that charge of Accelerated Learning Committee (dual-credit) includes CTE pathway programs for high school students to community colleges. Clarifies the grade level at which students can earn college credit, enabling them to earn college credit as freshmen and sophomores in high school. | Relating to accelerated learning | Education & Workforce Development | Enrolled Feb. 14: Passed by Senate 30-0 Feb. 21: Passed by House 56-0 |

| House | HB 4018 B | Modifies the deadline for the Technical and Regional Universities (TRUs) to request an institutional governing board. State Board of Higher Education may endorse a TRU board with conditions. Creates a task force to study the integration of CCWD into the HECC. Authorizes the HECC with rulemaking authority to set fees on educational institutions seeking to provide post-secondary distance education in Oregon. | Relating to higher education | Higher Education & Workforce Development | Mar 6: Passed in House 55-0 |
| House | HB 4019 B | Requires community colleges and universities to provide fact sheets on program requirements, costs, student loans and default rates, and average salary or wages of graduates. Instructs institutions to provide annual reports to the HECC. Empowers HECC to increase reporting requirements without undue burden to universities. Operative July 1, 2015. | House | HB 4116 B | Directs CCWD and the HECC to establish a competitive grant program to increase community college enrollment among under-served (low-income and first-generation) populations. | Senate | SB 1581 A | Directs public universities and community colleges to increase voter registration access and information. | House | HB 4024 | Authorizes Bureau of Labor and Industries (BOLI) to adopt rules to implement provisions of statute requiring public employer to interview each veteran who applies for civil service position or eligibility list, if veteran has skills from military education or experience that substantially relate to civil service position | Relating to veterans who apply for civil service positions | Veterans' Services and Emergency Preparedness | Bill did not pass out of committee ("dead") |
| House | HB 4046 | Study on effects of cormorant predation on juvenile salmonids | Relating to Financial administration of State Dept. Fish & Wildlife | Agriculture & Natural Resources | Bill did not pass out of committee ("dead") |

| House | HB 4102 A | Regulates third party contracts for managing student financial aid accounts, requiring fee schedule transparency and prohibiting debit swipe fees and revenue sharing.
